PANTHER CREEK HOSPITAL, REGULATING Act of Jun. 14, 1911, P.L. 921, No. 724 AN ACT

Providing for an examination of the Panther Creek Valley Hospital; providing for the transfer, under certain conditions, of the said hospital to the Commonwealth; regulating said hospital in the event of such transfer; and making an appropriation to carry out the purpose of this act.

Whereas, The Panther Creek Valley Hospital Association has erected and fully equipped a hospital at Coaldale, Schuylkill County: and,

Whereas, Said hospital association is desirous of transferring and conveying said hospital, including all the buildings, grounds, and equipment appurtenant thereto, unto the Commonwealth, to be hereafter maintained as a State Hospital; therefore, -Section 1. (1 repealed June 7, 1923, P.L.498, No.274)

Section 1. (1 repealed June 7, 1923, P.L.498, No.274) Section 2. Said Board of Trustees shall have full charge and supervision of said hospital and its affairs. It shall, subject to the approval of the Governor, prepare such rules and regulations for the government of said hospital as it may deem necessary. It shall report annually to the Governor, in writing, on or before the first day of December.

Section 3. Subject to the approval of the Governor, the Board of Trustees may appoint such persons, male and female, as it may deem necessary, in the maintenance of said hospital, and at such compensation as shall be fixed by the Governor.
