

FLAGS, DISPLAY OF
Act of 1913, P.L. 419, No. 276

To authorize the display of the State, county, city, borough, or other municipal flags on public buildings in the Commonwealth.

Compiler's Note: Section 2101 of Act 69 of 1933 provided that Act 276 is repealed insofar as it relates to second class townships.

Compiler's Note: Section 3501 of Act 331 of 1931 provided that Act 276 is repealed insofar as it relates to first class townships.

Compiler's Note: Section 4701 of Act 317 of 1931 provided that Act 276 is repealed insofar as it relates to third class cities.

Compiler's Note: Section 1051 of Act 447 of 1929 provided that Act 276 is repealed as it relates to county buildings except in counties of the first class.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That after the approval of this act it shall be lawful to display the flag of Pennsylvania on any public building in this Commonwealth.

Section 2. That after the approval of this act it shall be lawful to display the flag of any county, city, borough, or other municipality in the State on the public buildings of any county, city, borough, or other municipality of the State.

Section 3. It shall be lawful to display the flag of Pennsylvania over a memorial, a casket and at a funeral procession of a deceased individual who was a member or employe of a volunteer or municipal police department, fire department, ambulance service or rescue squad or a fire police organization.
