COUNTY BRIDGES, COMMONWEALTH AUTHORIZED TO REBUILD Act of May. 16, 1919, P.L. 196, No. 122 Cl. 36 AN ACT

Authorizing the Commonwealth to rebuild county bridges, over eight hundred feet in length, located on State highways, where such bridges have been heretofore destroyed by fire; providing for the appointment of viewers and inspectors, and for the payment of the costs of rebuilding such bridges; and imposing certain charges upon counties.

Section 14. Liability to maintain and repair bridge Until otherwise by law provided, all bridges erected under the provisions of this act shall be maintained and kept in good repair by the county in which the same may be located. 1919, May 16, P.L. 196, Sec. 14.
