COUNTIES, AUTHORIZATION TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO AGRICULTURAL SOCIETIES

Authorizing the county commissioners to appropriate county moneys to incorporated agricultural and horticultural societies and associations.

Compiler's Note: Section 1051 of Act 447 of 1929 provided that Act 53 is repealed except insofar as it relates to counties of the first class.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the county commissioners of the several counties of this Commonwealth are hereby authorized to appropriate, annually, out of the current revenues of the county, moneys to any incorporated agricultural or horticultural society or association located within the county. The total amount of any such appropriation in any one county shall not exceed fifteen hundred dollars in any one year, and where more than one such society or association is located in the county, the amount appropriated may be distributed and divided among said societies and associations in such proportions and such amounts as the board of county commissioners, in its discretion, may determine.
