TRANSFER OF RECORDS RELATING TO ROADS TO DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS

Act of Apr. 7, 1927, P.L. 138, No. 109 AN ACT Cl. 36

Providing for the transfer of records and papers relating to roads from the Secretary of Internal Affairs to the Department of Highways.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That all maps, drafts, reports, and other papers relating to State or turnpike roads, now remaining in the office of the Secretary of Internal Affairs, shall, as soon as practicable after the passage of this act, be transferred to the Department of Highways, which department is directed to receive and deposit the same and to preserve the same for future use.
