STATE TREASURER'S CHECKS VOID AFTER 60 DAYS Act of Apr. 27, 1927, P.L. 418, No. 272

AN ACT

Rendering cheques issued by the State Treasurer void unless presented for payment within sixty days from the date thereof, and providing for the issuance of duplicate cheques upon surrender of cheques voided by delay in presentation.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That all cheques issued by the State Treasurer of this Commonwealth shall become and be void, unless presented to the Treasury Department for payment within sixty days from the date thereof: Provided, however, That upon the surrender of any such cheque, which shall have become void by reason of the failure of the holder thereof to present the same for payment within sixty days as hereinabove provided, the State Treasurer shall issue a new cheque to the payee or payees named in the cheque surrendered in the amount of such cheque.

Section 2. Every cheque issued by the Treasury Department after the effective date of this act shall have printed thereon the words "Void unless presented for payment within sixty days."
