

COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AUTHORIZED TO SELL LAND

AN ACT

Authorizing and empowering county commissioners, under certain circumstances, to use for another purpose land acquired by the county for a particular purpose.

Compiler's Note: Section 26 of Act 146 of 1931 provided that Act 76 is repealed except as relates to counties of the first class.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That in all cases where a county has acquired land for one purpose, and all thereof is not required for such purpose, the county commissioners may appropriate and use so much thereof as is not so required for any other purpose for which the county commissioners have been or shall hereafter be authorized and empowered to acquire lands.
