## DEPARTMENT OF FOREST AND WATERS TO RECEIVE FEDERAL FUNDS Act of Jun. 23, 1931, P.L. 1202, No. 328 AN ACT

Authorizing the Department of Forests and Waters to cooperate with and to receive contributions from the Federal Government for forestry purposes; and providing for the use of such contributions.

**Compiler's Note:** Section 302(h) of Act 18 of 1995, which created the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources and renamed the Department of Environmental Resources as the Department of Environmental Protection, provided that the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources shall exercise the powers and duties conferred upon the Department of Forests and Waters by Act 328 of 1931.

Section 1. Forest protection; Department of Forest and Waters authorized to enter into agreements with United States

The Department of Forests and Waters is hereby empowered and authorized to cooperate and enter into cooperative agreements with, and to receive contributions from, the United States government for the protection from fire, or other casualty, the development and the production of forests and forest producing lands. All contributions received hereunder from the United States government shall be paid into the State Treasury, through the Department of Revenue, and credited to the biennial appropriations to the Department of Forests and Waters for the same purposes for which the contributions were made. 1931, June 23, P.L. 1202, No. 328, Sec. 1.
