## AUTOPSIES IN SIXTH CLASS COUNTIES Act of Jun. 25, 1931, P.L. 1360, No. 333 Cl. 16

AN ACT

Limiting the liability of counties of the sixth class for the cost of autopsies in coroners' cases.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That no county of the sixth class shall be liable for the payment of more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) as the cost of any autopsy in any case being investigated by a coroner unless the expenditure for such autopsy has first been approved by the county commissioners of the county.

Section 2. All acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed; but this act shall not be construed to repeal any local or special law.
