## TRANSFERRING POWERS FROM STATE COUNCIL TO STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION Act of Aug. 8, 1963, P.L. 613, No. 321 Cl. 24

AN ACT

Transferring powers and duties from the State Council of Education to the State Board of Education and making an appropriation to the Department of Public Instruction for administrative expenses of the State Board of Education.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. All powers and duties imposed upon the State Council of Education by the "Public School Code of 1949," and its amendments, are hereby transferred to and imposed upon the State Board of Education, unless otherwise specifically provided by law.

Section 2. The sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Department of Public Instruction for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1963, for salaries, wages and all necessary expenses of the State Board of Education and its Council of Basic Education and Council of Higher Education as authorized by The Administrative Code of 1929.
