

COLUMBUS DAY - OBSERVANCE ON OCTOBER 12
Act of Aug. 13, 1963, P.L. 660, No. 345
AN ACT

CL. 38

Providing for the observance of October 12 of each year as
Columbus Day.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The Governor shall issue, annually, his
Proclamation designating and setting apart October 12 as
Columbus Day, and calling upon the people of the Commonwealth,
the public schools and other educational institutions and
historical organizations to observe the discovery of the New
World with appropriate exercises and programs, to the end that
the discovery of America shall be commemorated each year.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
