AN ACT

Regulating the importation and sale of live turtles and providing for permits to be issued by the Department of Health.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. No person shall sell, hold for sale or offer for any type of commercial or public distribution any live turtle or lot of turtles in this Commonwealth if the sale, holding for sale or offering for any type of commercial or public distribution of such turtle or lot of turtles is prohibited by Federal statute or regulation, including 21 CFR § 1240.62 (relating to turtles intrastate and interstate requirements).

Section 7. Instructions designating the proper care and treatment of live turtles and information from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention on human salmonellosis infection associated with reptiles shall accompany each retail sale of any turtle and shall be distributed to the purchaser by the seller thereof at the time of the sale.
