

TRANSFER ALTOONA ACID MINE DRAINAGE TREATMENT PLANT TO ALTOONA
Act of Jul. 30, 1975, P.L. 145, No. 72
AN ACT

Authorizing the Department of Environmental Resources, with the approval of the Governor, to convey title of the Altoona Acid Mine Drainage Treatment Plant to the City of Altoona, subject to a right of reverter for stated conditions.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The Department of Environmental Resources, with the approval of the Governor, is hereby authorized on behalf of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to convey title to the Altoona Acid Mine Drainage Treatment Plant, Altoona, Pennsylvania, to the City of Altoona, County of Blair, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, for the following purposes: the City of Altoona or its designee shall continuously operate and maintain said acid mine drainage treatment plant and continuously treat the full flow of Kittanning Run up to the 15 million gallons per day maximum capacity of said plant.

Compiler's Note: The Department of Environmental Resources, referred to in this section, was abolished by Act 18 of 1995. Its functions were transferred to the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources and the Department of Environmental Protection.

Section 2. If, for any reason whatsoever, the city or its designee shall discontinue operation of the acid mine drainage treatment plant, the Department of Environmental Resources is hereby granted the right to retake possession and title to said plant for purposes of continued operation or at the Department's option, dismantling.

Section 3. The deed of conveyance shall be approved by the Department of Justice and shall be executed by the Secretary of the Department of Environmental Resources in the name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Compiler's Note: The Secretary of Environmental Resources, referred to in this section, was abolished by Act 18 of 1995. The functions of the secretary were transferred to the Secretary of Conservation and Natural Resources and the Secretary of Environmental Protection.

Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
