WRIGHT'S FERRY BRIDGE - DESIGNATION Act of Jul. 9, 1976, P.L. 907, No. 162 Cl. 87 AN ACT

Naming a bridge over the Susquehanna River, the Wright's Ferry Bridge.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The bridge over the Susquehanna River, immediately to the north of the span between Columbia, Lancaster County and Wrightsville, York County, on U.S. Route 30, shall hereafter be known as the Wright's Ferry Bridge.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
