RELEASE OF PROJECT 500 LAND - ALLEGHENY COUNTY Act of Jul. 3, 1980, P.L. 377, No. 95

AN ACT

Providing for the release of certain Project 500 land situated in the City of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County from restrictions on use or other encumbrances so that it may be conveyed for use in conjunction with nonprofit senior citizens housing.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The following described land situated in the City of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County, is hereby released from any restrictions on use or other encumbrances on title resulting from the provisions of the act of January 19, 1968 (1967 P.L.996, No.443), known as "The Land and Water Conservation and Reclamation Act" so that such land may be conveyed by the City of Pittsburgh to the National Church Residence of Brookline, Pennsylvania, a nonprofit corporation, for the purpose of senior citizen housing and required recreational open space relating thereto.

Being the following described lots from the Allegheny County Lot and Block System: 96-B-252, Lots 451, 452 and 453; 96-B-248 Lots 454 and 455 for 5th Ward Brookline Plan 60 as recorded in Plan Book Vol. 25, Page 46, 19th Ward, City of Pittsburgh, County of Allegheny.

Section 2. The Department of Justice shall prepare and the Secretary of Community Affairs shall execute on behalf of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania a release pursuant to the provisions of this act which release shall be recorded in the Office of Recorder of Deeds in Allegheny County.

Compiler's Note: The Secretary of Community Affairs, referred to in this section, was abolished by Act 58 of 1996 and the functions were transferred to the Secretary of Community and Economic Development.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
