NAME OF GLASGOW BRIDGE IN BEAVER COUNTY CHANGED TO BRIDGE OF THE NORTHWEST TERRITORY

AN ACT

Changing the name of the Glasgow Bridge in Beaver County to the Bridge of the Northwest Territory.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The bridge on Legislative Route 243 crossing the Little Beaver River between the Boroughs of Glasgow and Ohioville in Beaver County, known as the Glasgow Bridge, is hereby designated and shall hereafter be known as the Bridge of the Northwest Territory.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
