INTERSTATE ROUTES 80, 81, AND 83 - NAME DESIGNATIONS Act of Oct. 4, 1984, P.L. 724, No. 155

AN ACT

Designating the entire portion of Interstate Route 81 in Pennsylvania as the American Legion Memorial Highway; designating the entire portion of Keystone Highway Interstate Route 80 in Pennsylvania as the Z. H. Confair Memorial Highway; designating the entire portion of Interstate Route 83 in Pennsylvania as the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States Memorial Highway; requiring the Department of Transportation to erect signs designating Indiantown Gap National Cemetery; and making an appropriation.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The entire portion of Interstate Route 81 situate in Pennsylvania shall hereafter be known as the American Legion Memorial Highway.

Section 2. The Department of Transportation shall erect appropriate signs on Interstate Route 81 indicating Indiantown Gap National Cemetery.

Section 3. The entire portion of Keystone Highway Interstate Route 80 situate in Pennsylvania shall hereafter be known as the Z. H. Confair Memorial Highway.

Section 4. The Department of Transportation shall erect the appropriate signs to indicate these highway designations to the motoring public.

Section 5. The entire portion of Interstate Route 83 in Pennsylvania shall hereafter be known as the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States Memorial Highway.

Section 6. The sum of \$8,000 is appropriated to the Department of Transportation to carry out the purposes of section 2 of this act.

Section 7. This act shall take effect immediately.
