

**CORPORAL DAVID WILLIAM WITMER MEMORIAL HIGHWAY - DESIGNATION**  
**Act of Dec. 12, 1984, P.L. 984, No. 197**

**AN ACT**

Designating a section of Route 225 in Northumberland County as the Corporal David William Witmer Memorial Highway.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The section of Route 225 (Legislative Route 336) in Northumberland County between Range Station 849 + 56 near the intersection of Route 61 City of Shamokin and Range Station 1210 + 01 in Zerbe Township shall hereafter be known and shall be designated and posted, at least at either end, by the Department of Transportation as the Corporal David William Witmer Memorial Highway.

Section 2. Corporal David William Witmer of the Shamokin City Police Department was killed in the line of duty on November 13, 1983, while responding to a mutual-aid police call in Zerbe Township.

Section 3. This act shall take effect November 13, 1984.
