## BOAT AND FISH FUNDS CAPITAL BUDGET ACT FOR 1986-1987 Act of Jul. 8, 1986, P.L. 543, No. 95 Cl. 86 AN ACT

Providing for the adoption of capital projects to be financed from current revenues of the Boat and Fish Funds.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Short title.

This act shall be known and may be cited as the Boat and Fish Funds Capital Budget Act for 1986-1987. Section 2. Total authorizations.

The total authorization for the capital projects in the category of public improvement projects itemized in section 3 to be constructed by the Pennsylvania Fish Commission, and to be financed from current revenues of the Boat Fund and the Fish Fund pursuant to executive authorizations, shall be \$460,000.

Section 3. Itemization of Fish Commission capital projects. The individual capital projects in the category of public improvement projects to be constructed by the Pennsylvania Fish Commission, and to be financed from current revenues of the Boat Fund and the Fish Fund pursuant to executive authorizations, are hereby itemized, together with their respective estimated costs, as follows:

(1) Centre County

- (i) Expansion of Centre County Fish Rearing \$110,000 Facility
- (2) Fayette County
  - (i) Development of East Fredericktown Access 125,000 Area

(Boat Fund - \$94,000) (Fish Fund - \$31,000)

- (3) Lackawanna County
  - (i) Improvements to the Ford Lake Dam 225,000 (Fish Fund \$225,000)

Section 4. Effective date.

This act shall take effect July 1, 1986, or immediately, whichever is later.
