

FREEDOM BRIDGE - DESIGNATION
Act of Apr. 13, 1988, P.L. 348, No. 50

Designating the bridge on Route 21 over Ten Mile Creek in
Franklin Township, Greene County, as the Freedom Bridge.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The bridge on Route 21 over Ten Mile Creek, one-
quarter mile east of Waynesburg, in Franklin Township, Greene
County, is hereby designated and shall be known as the Freedom
Bridge.

Section 2. The Secretary of Transportation shall erect
suitable markers in order to carry out this act.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
