GOLD STAR MOTHERS BRIDGE - DESIGNATION Act of Nov. 21, 1988, P.L. 1081, No. 124 Cl. 87

AN ACT

Designating the new bridge at Hyner, Pennsylvania, in Chapman Township, Clinton County, as the Gold Star Mothers Bridge in honor and memory of veterans and their mothers.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The newly constructed bridge at Hyner, Pennsylvania, over the West Branch of the Susquehanna River in Chapman Township, Clinton County, on State Route 120 is hereby designated and shall be known as the Gold Star Mothers Bridge.

Section 2. The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain suitable markers on both sides of the bridge, which shall evidence the name of the bridge designated by section 1.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
