

GAME FUND CAPITAL BUDGET ACT FOR 1988-1989

Act of Dec. 19, 1988, P.L. 1284, No. 160

AN ACT

Providing for the adoption of capital projects to be financed from current revenues of the Game Fund.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Short title.

This act shall be known and may be cited as the Game Fund Capital Budget Act for 1988-1989.

Section 2. Total authorizations.

The total authorization for the capital projects in the category of public improvement projects to be acquired by the Pennsylvania Game Commission, and to be financed from current revenues of the Game Fund pursuant to executive authorizations, shall be \$3,003,000.

Section 3. Itemization of Pennsylvania Game Commission capital projects.

The individual capital projects in the category of public improvement projects to be acquired by the Pennsylvania Game Commission, and to be financed from current revenues of the Game Fund pursuant to executive authorizations, are hereby itemized, together with their respective estimated costs, as follows:

- (1) Blair County
 - (i) Land Acquisition - Tyrone Twp. - 1,450 Acres \$327,000
- (2) Butler County
 - (i) Land Acquisition - Clearfield Twp. - 460 Acres 115,000
- (3) Carbon County
 - (i) Land Acquisition - Lehigh and Mauch Chunk Twps. - 2,600 Acres 845,000
- (4) Cumberland County
 - (i) Land Acquisition - South Middleton Twp. - 750 Acres 300,000
- (5) Elk County
 - (i) Land Acquisition - Ridgway Twp. - 710 Acres 184,000
- (6) Huntingdon County
 - (i) Land Acquisition - Jackson Twp. - 750 Acres 283,000
- (7) Lackawanna County
 - (i) Land Acquisition - Archbald Borough, Scott and Carbondale Twps. - 1,060 Acres 297,000
- (8) Luzerne County
 - (i) Land Acquisition - Bear Creek Twp. - 600 Acres 240,000
- (9) Warren County
 - (i) Land Acquisition - Columbus Twp. - 404 Acres 122,000
 - (ii) Land Acquisition - Triumph Twp. - 965 Acres 290,000

Section 4. Effective date.

This act shall take effect immediately.
