AN ACT

Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled
"An act concerning townships of the first class; amending,
revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating
thereto," authorizing appropriations for certain streets.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1502 of the act of June 24, 1931
(P.L.1206, No.331), known as The First Class Township Code,
reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569), is
amended by adding a clause to read:

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

Section 1502. The corporate power of a township of the first
class shall be vested in the board of township commissioners.
The board shall have power--

XLIX.I. Appropriations for Certain Streets. To appropriate
money annually for improvements to any street as defined in
section 102, located wholly or partially within the township,
whether township owned or not, which has been adversely affected
by parking availability as determined by the commissioners.
