AN ACT

Amending the act of February 1, 1966 (1965 P.L.1656, No.581),
entitled "An act concerning boroughs, and revising, amending
and consolidating the law relating to boroughs," providing
for residence requirements for borough officers.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 801 of the act of February 1, 1966 (1965
P.L.1656, No.581), known as The Borough Code, is amended to
read:

Section 801. Electors Only to be Eligible;
Incompatibility.--Registered electors of the borough only shall
be eligible to elective borough offices. **All elected borough
officers shall reside in the borough from which elected and
shall have resided in the borough continuously for at least one
year before their election.** A school director shall not be
eligible to an elective borough office. No individual shall at
the same time hold more than one elective borough office.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
