AN ACT

Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for firefighters with outof-State training and certification.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 7316 of Title 35 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: § 7316. Pennsylvania State Fire Academy. * * *

(e) Out-of-State firefighter training and certification.--A firefighter or prospective firefighter is eligible for in-State firefighter course accreditation, without additional training, if the firefighter submits proof of successful completion of an out-of-State training course with standards equivalent to the training standards of Pennsylvania. The agency shall establish procedures for determining equivalency and for certifying firefighters who have obtained firefighter training or certification from any other state.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
