AN ACT

Amending the act of July 8, 1986 (P.L.408, No.89), entitled "An act providing for the creation of the Health Care Cost Containment Council, for its powers and duties, for health care cost containment through the collection and dissemination of data, for public accountability of health care costs and for health care for the indigent; establishing the Indigent Care Program; and making an appropriation," further providing for expiration of the act; and making an appropriation.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 19 of the act of July 8, 1986 (P.L.408, No.89), known as the Health Care Cost Containment Act, is amended to read:

Section 19. Sunset.

This act shall expire [December 31, 1992, unless reestablished prior to that date in accordance with the act of December 22, 1981 (P.L.508, No.142), known as the Sunset Act] **June 30, 1993, unless reenacted prior to that date** .

Section 2. The sum of \$1,000,000, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Health Care Cost Containment Council for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1993, for the operation of the Health Care Cost Containment Council.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
