AN ACT

Amending the act of July 2, 1984 (P.L.553, No.110), entitled, as reenacted, "An act establishing a program within the Department of Commerce to provide grants to engineering degree-granting schools to assist in the acquisition of new engineering equipment or the upgrading of existing engineering equipment that is necessary to provide students with the courses required to obtain a degree in engineering," further providing for reallocation of unused funds and for the expiration of the act.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Sections 3(d) and 6 of the act of July 2, 1984 (P.L.553, No.110), known as the Engineering School Equipment Act, reenacted and amended December 17, 1990 (P.L.712, No.177) are amended to read:

Section 3. Engineering equipment acquisition and upgrade. * * *

(d) Distribution of unused funds.—Any allocated funds which have not been expended consistent with subsection (c) by June 30, [1992] **1995**, shall be available for reallocation by the board.

Section 6. Expiration.

This act shall expire June 30, [1993] 1996.

Section 2. This act shall be retroactive to June 30, 1993, if enacted after June 30, 1993.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
