

HIGHWAY SUPPLEMENT TO THE CAPITAL BUDGET ACT OF 1993-1994

A SUPPLEMENT

To the act of June 28, 1993 (P.L.134, No.31), entitled "An act providing for the capital budget for the fiscal year 1993-1994," itemizing public highway projects to be constructed by current revenues of the Department of Transportation, together with the estimated financial costs; and making appropriations.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Short title.

This act shall be known and may be cited as the Highway Supplement to the Capital Budget Act of 1993-1994.

Section 2. Authorization.

The total authorization for the capital projects in the category of highway projects itemized in section 3 and to be constructed by the Department of Transportation, its successors or assigns, and to be financed by current revenues of the Motor License Fund shall be \$400,000.

Section 3. Itemization.

Additional capital projects in the category of public highway projects to be constructed by the Department of Transportation, its successors or assigns, and to be financed by current revenues of the Motor License Fund are hereby itemized, together with their respective estimated financial costs, as follows:

(A) Construct access road from the Pennsylvania Turnpike to the New Cumberland Army Depot and install traffic signals	400,000
(Base Project Allocation - \$400,000)	

Section 4. Federal funds.

All moneys received from the Federal Government for the projects specifically itemized in this act are also hereby appropriated for those projects.

Section 5. Allocation of funds.

Whenever as determined by the Department of Transportation that the full estimated financial costs of the projects itemized in section 3 are not necessary for the proper design, acquisition or construction of such projects, the excess funds no longer required may be allocated by the Department of Transportation to increase the estimated costs of any one or more of the projects specifically itemized in a capital budget.

Section 6. Effective date.

This act shall take effect immediately.
