AN ACT

Amending the act of December 16, 1986 (P.L.1646, No.188),
entitled "An act providing for the licensing of chiropractors
and the regulation of the practice of chiropractic;
establishing the State Board of Chiropractic in the
Department of State and providing for its powers and duties;
providing for the supervision of colleges of chiropractic,
for the examination of applicants, for enforcement and for
disciplinary actions; providing penalties; and making
repeals," providing for unlicensed supportive personnel.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of December 16, 1986 (P.L.1646, No.188),
known as the Chiropractic Practice Act, is amended by adding a
chapter to read:

CHAPTER 6

SUPPORTIVE PERSONNEL

Section 601. Supportive personnel.

**Nothing in this act shall prohibit a licensed chiropractor
from utilizing the assistance of unlicensed supportive personnel
performing under the direct on-premises supervision of a
licensed chiropractor, provided that a chiropractor may not
delegate any activity or duty to such unlicensed individuals
which requires formal education or training in the practice of
chiropractic or the knowledge and skill of a licensed
chiropractor.**

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
