## REPEALS - OBSOLETE LAW RELATING TO HARRISBURG STREET PAVING AND CURBING

## Act of Feb. 18, 1998, P.L. 196, No. 33 Cl. 88 AN ACT

Repealing the act of May 8, 1889 (P.L.125, No.138), entitled "An act providing for the paving and curbing of such portions of Third street, Fourth street, Walnut street and North street in the City of Harrisburg, as the Public Grounds of the Commonwealth abut on, as is properly chargeable to the State, and making appropriation for the cost of the same."

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of May 8, 1889 (P.L.125, No.138), entitled "An act providing for the paving and curbing of such portions of Third street, Fourth street, Walnut street and North street in the City of Harrisburg, as the Public Grounds of the Commonwealth abut on, as is properly chargeable to the State, and making appropriation for the cost of the same," is repealed. Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
