

JOHN J. SHUMAKER MEMORIAL HIGHWAY - DESIGNATION

Act of Jun. 19, 2001, P.L. 279, No. 19

AN ACT

Designating a portion of Routes 22 and 322 in Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, as the John J. Shumaker Memorial Highway.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. John J. Shumaker Memorial Highway.

(a) Designation.--West of the Borough of Dauphin, beginning at the Clarks Ferry Bridge and continuing east on Routes 22 and 322 until ending at the beginning of the William B. Lentz Memorial Highway, is hereby designated and shall be known as the John J. Shumaker Memorial Highway.

(b) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain road signs, which shall display the name of John J. Shumaker Memorial Highway, at the beginning and the end of the section of the highway designated in subsection (a).

Section 2. Effective date.

This act shall take effect immediately.
