AN ACT

Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," providing for appropriations to conservation districts.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as The First Class Township Code, reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569), is amended by adding a section to read:

Section 1316. Conservation District.—The board of commissioners may make appropriations to the conservation district, as defined in the act of May 15, 1945 (P.L.547, No.217), known as the "Conservation District Law," in which the township is located.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
