AN ACT

Amending Title 30 (Fish) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the disposition of the proceeds from the special Lake Erie fishing permits.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 2907.2(f) of Title 30 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

§ 2907.2. Lake Erie fishing permits.

* * *

(f) Proceeds from special permit.--The proceeds from the special permits issued under this section shall be deposited into a restricted account within the Fish Fund, which account shall be used for paying recompense to holders of gill net licenses for boundary lakes as provided in section 2903(h) (relating to gill nets) and for the costs of administering the recompense and special permit programs. The holders of gill net licenses shall have until July 10, 2002, and no later to accept the recompense payment calculated as provided in section 2903(h). The balance in the restricted account shall be used to acquire property and to provide public fishing access on or at Lake Erie, its tributaries and Presque Isle Bay.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
