AN ACT

Amending the act of June 14, 1961 (P.L.324, No.188), entitled "An act relating to the establishment, operation and maintenance of the State Library and public libraries in the Commonwealth; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto; imposing duties upon public officers; providing for State and local cooperation and assistance in the establishment and maintenance of libraries; prescribing penalties; and repealing existing laws," further providing for local library use of incentive for excellence funds.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 303.5(d) of the act of June 14, 1961 (P.L.324, No.188), known as The Library Code, amended June 22, 2001 (P.L.554, No.36), is amended to read:

Section 303.5. Incentive For Excellence Aid.--* * *

(d) A local library or library system shall not use incentive for excellence funds to reduce its financial effort[.] **for normal, recurring operating costs from a previous level unless evidence of substantial curtailment of financial ability of the community is accepted by the State Librarian.**

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
