

FRED JAINDL MEMORIAL HIGHWAY - DESIGNATION

Designating the proposed Route 222 bypass in Lehigh County from the point immediately South of I-78 in Lower Macungie Township, Lehigh County, through portions of Upper Macungie Township, Lehigh County, to the south interchange of Route 100 in Lower Macungie Township, Lehigh County, as the Fred Jandl Memorial Highway.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Fred Jandl Memorial Highway.

(a) Designation.--The portion of the proposed Route 222 bypass in Lehigh County from the point immediately south of I-78 in Lower Macungie Township, Lehigh County, through portions of Upper Macungie Township to the south interchange of Route 100 in Lower Macungie Township, Lehigh County, is hereby designated and shall be known as the Fred Jandl Memorial Highway.

(b) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain signs which shall display the name of the highway designated in subsection (a) at each end of the named segment.

Section 2. Effective date.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.
