

**DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION AND NATURAL RESOURCES - AGREE TO HOLD AND SAVE  
UNITED STATES ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS FREE FROM CERTAIN DAMAGES ARISING  
FROM CERTAIN CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS**

**Act of Jul. 14, 2005, P.L. 277, No. 47**

AN ACT

Authorizing the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources on behalf of the Commonwealth to agree to hold and save the United States Army Corps of Engineers free from certain damages arising from certain construction projects.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Hold harmless.

The Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, acting for and in the name of the Commonwealth, is authorized to agree to hold and save the United States Army Corps of Engineers free from all damages arising from construction, operation and maintenance of projects along the Delaware Canal State Park involving cooperative agreements between the Commonwealth and the United States Army Corps of Engineers, except for any damages due to the fault or negligence of the United States Army Corps of Engineers.

Section 2. Effective date.

This act shall take effect immediately.
