AN ACT

Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the offense of trespass on private property while hunting; and prescribing penalties.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Title 34 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

- § 2314. Trespass on private property while hunting.
- (a) General rule.--Any person who while violating any provision of this title or any regulations promulgated under this title and who in addition is found to be trespassing as defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 3503 (relating to criminal trespass) shall be in violation of this section.
 - (b) Penalty. -- A violation of this section:
 - (1) For a first offense is a summary offense.
 - (2) For a second or subsequent offense within one year of the prior offense is a summary offense and upon conviction will result in an immediate revocation of the person's hunting and furtaking license and disqualification of the person from issuance of a future license for a period of one year from the date of revocation.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
