## CARNEGIE MUSEUMS OF PITTSBURGH - OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE EXPENSES AND PURCHASE OF APPARATUS, SUPPLIES, AND EQUIPMENT Act of Jul. 7, 2006, P.L. 1836, No. 33A

AN ACT

Making appropriations to the Carnegie Museums of Pittsburgh for operations and maintenance expenses and the purchase of apparatus, supplies and equipment.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The sum of \$254,000 is hereby appropriated to the Carnegie Museums of Pittsburgh for the fiscal year July 1, 2006, to June 30, 2007, for the Carnegie Museum of Natural History for maintenance and the purchase of apparatus, supplies and equipment.

Section 2. The sum of \$254,000 is hereby appropriated to the Carnegie Museums of Pittsburgh for the fiscal year July 1, 2006, to June 30, 2007, for the Carnegie Science Center for the general operation of the planetarium and center.

Section 3. Payments to the Carnegie Museums of Pittsburgh on account of the appropriations provided in sections 1 and 2 shall be made quarterly by the Executive Director of the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission.

Section 4. The Carnegie Museums of Pittsburgh shall provide full, complete and accurate information as may be required by the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission or the chairman or the minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the chairman or the minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives.

Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006, or immediately, whichever is later.
