AN ACT

Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for compulsory arbitration.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 7361(b) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, amended November 30, 2004 (P.L.1703, No.217), is amended to read:

§ 7361. Compulsory arbitration.

* * *

- (b) Limitations.--No matter shall be referred under subsection (a):
 - (1) which involves title to real property; or
 - (2) where the amount in controversy, exclusive of interest and costs, exceeds[:
 - (i) \$50,000 in judicial districts embracing first, second, second class A or third class counties or home rule counties which but for the adoption of a home rule charter would be a county of one of these classes; or
 - (ii) \$35,000 in any other judicial district.] \$50,000.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
