

BATTLE OF THE BULGE VETERANS MEMORIAL HIGHWAY - DESIGNATION

AN ACT

Designating a portion of State Route 145 in Northampton and Lehigh Counties as the Battle of the Bulge Veterans Memorial Highway.
(Title amended July 7, 2011, P.L.224, No.42)

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Battle of the Bulge Veterans Memorial Highway.

(a) Designation.--State Route 145 in Whitehall Township, Lehigh County, from the intersection of US Route 22 northward to the intersection of Main Street in the Borough of Walnutport, Northampton County, is hereby designated as the Battle of the Bulge Veterans Memorial Highway. ((a) amended July 7, 2011, P.L.224, No.42)

(b) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs to indicate the designation under subsection (a).

Section 2. Effective date.

This act shall take effect in 30 days.
