AN ACT

Amending the act of June 1, 1956 (1955 P.L.1944, No.655), entitled "An act providing a permanent allocation of a part of the fuels and liquids fuels tax proceeds to cities, boroughs, incorporated towns and townships, for their road, street and bridge purposes; conferring powers and imposing duties on local officers and the Department of Highways; and making an appropriation out of the Motor License Fund; and repealing existing legislation," further providing for allocated money.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 4(3) of the act of June 1, 1956 (1955 P.L.1944, No.655), referred to as the Liquid Fuels Tax Municipal Allocation Law, amended November 23, 2004 (P.L.944, No.138), is amended to read:

Section 4. The money hereby appropriated to municipalities shall be paid to the municipalities in accordance with the following formula and subject to the provisions of this act:

(3) The moneys allocated in clause (1) shall be paid over, in the manner provided by law, by the department to the respective cities, boroughs, towns and townships, on the first days of July and December, 1956, and the first day of [April] **March** of each subsequent year.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
