## PROJECT 70 LANDS - RELEASE OF RESTRICTIONS IN PLYMOUTH TOWNSHIP,

 LUZERNE COUNTYAct of Jun. 30, 2015, P.L. 86, No. 14 Cl. 68 An Act

Authorizing the disposition of certain lands situate in Plymouth Township, Luzerne County, subject to Project 70 restrictions.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Release of Project 70 restrictions on property in Plymouth Township, Luzerne County.
(a) Authorization.--Under the requirements of Section 20 (b) of the act of June 22, 1964 (Sp.Sess., P.L.131, No.8), known as the Project 70 Land Acquisition and Borrowing Act, the General Assembly hereby authorizes the disposition of the lands described in subsection (b).
(b) Lands to be disposed of with Project 70
restrictions.--The disposition of property currently owned by the County of Luzerne to be acquired by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, by and through the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, is as follows:

All those eight certain pieces, parcels or lots of land, situate, lying and being in the Township of Plymouth, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows, to wit: PARCEL ONE
THE FIRST THEREOF:
BEGINNING, a point in the center line of a private road leading from the Public Road running from Cease Mills to Hunlock Creek and extending to property now or late of Joseph Krystopa, said BEGINNING point being in line between lands formerly of Petronela Kapuscinski and lands of now or late of Joseph Krystopa;

THENCE from said beginning point along the center of said private road North 25 degrees 27 minutes West, 323.25 feet to a point in line with the center of a stone wall now standing on the ground.

THENCE along other lands formerly of the said stone wall and its projection North 60 degrees 07 minutes East, 740.38 feet to a point;

THENCE from said beginning point along the center of said private road North 25 degrees 27 minutes West 323.25 feet to a point in line with the center of a stone wall now standing on the ground;

THENCE along other lands formerly of the said Petronela Kapuscinski and following along the center line of said stone wall and its projection North 60 degrees 07 minutes East 740.38 feet to a point.

THENCE still along line of lands formerly of Petronela Kapuscinski, North 49 degrees 30 minutes East, 420 feet to a point;

THENCE still along the line of lands formerly of said Petronela Kapuscinski North 6 degrees 02 minutes East 1700 feet to a corner in line of lands of Spring Brook Water Supply Company;

THENCE along the line of same South 64 degrees 13 minutes East, 320 feet to a corner;

THENCE still along line of said lands South 6 degrees 02 minutes West 1528 feet to a corner in line of land now or late of Joseph Krystopa, aforesaid, and

THENCE along the line of said Krystopa lands South 49 degrees 20 minutes West 1490 feet to the place of BEGINNING.

Containing twenty (20) acres of land strict measure.
THE SECOND THEREOF:
BEGINNING at a stake and stones corner, same being in the Northeast corner of said Lot No. 7, described in said deed of partition above referenced to, said corner being corner of Lot No. 3, described in said deed of partition above referred to;

THENCE South thirty four (34) degrees East one hundred (100) perches to a corner in Lot No. 6, described in said deed of partition above referenced to;

THENCE South fifty six (56) degrees West seventy two (72) perches to a stake and stone corner of land sold by Susana Chaplain to James Williams and conveyed by said James Williams to Jamison Harvey;

THENCE north thirty-four (34) degrees West one hundred (100) perches to a stake and stones corner;

THENCE North fifty-six (56) degrees East seventy-two (72) perches to the place of BEGINNING.

Containing forty-five (45) acres of land, be the same more or
less.
BEING the same premises conveyed to the GRANTOR herein by Deed of John T. Bobeck, Jr. and Dorothy A Bobeck, dated October 9, 1966 and recorded in Luzerne County Deed Book 1688 at page 805 in confirmation of condemnation proceedings taken by the County of Luzerne and filed to No. 173 of 1966 in the Office of the Prothonotary for Luzerne County.
(c) Restriction.--Project 70 restrictions shall be imposed on the lands described in subsection (b) by the following deed clause:

This land to be used for park, recreation, and conservation purposes in accordance with provisions of the act of June 22, 1964 (Sp.Sess., P.L.131, No.8), known as the Project 70 Land Acquisition and Borrowing Act.
Section 2. Effective date.
This act shall take effect immediately.
