17 promulgation of regulations by the board implementing this

18 section.

19 Amend Bill, page 3, lines 12 and 13, by striking out "The

20 board shall renew, revoke or suspend the registration of

21 pharmacy technicians" and inserting

22 The board shall renew, refuse, revoke or suspend the

23 registration of pharmacy technicians and temporary permits for

24 pharmacy technician trainees, or otherwise discipline pharmacy

25 technicians and pharmacy technician trainees,

26 Amend Bill, page 3, line 17, by inserting after "action)."

27 Provisions and procedures with respect to refusal and

28 discipline contained in sections 5(a), (c) and (d) and 7 shall

29 apply to pharmacy technician registrations and pharmacy

1 technician trainee permits.

2 Amend Bill, page 4, line 12, by inserting after "state"

3 unless the provisions of section 3(a)(6)(i), (ii) and (iii)
4 have been satisfied

5 Amend Bill, page 4, line 19, by striking out "one year" and
6 inserting

7 two years

8 Amend Bill, page 4, line 20, by striking out "and may be
9 renewed for one additional year." and inserting

10 or upon obtaining registration as a pharmacy technician
11 under subsection (a).
