

## AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1532

1 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 9 through 12, by striking out all  
2 of said lines and inserting

3 Section 1. Section 9(b)(7) of the act of October 27, 2014  
4 (P.L.2911, No.191), known as the Achieving Better Care by  
5 Monitoring All Prescriptions Program (ABC-MAP) Act, is amended  
6 and the subsection is amended by adding a paragraph to read:

9 (7) Designated Commonwealth personnel and contracted  
10 staff who are responsible for the development and evaluation  
11 of quality improvement strategies, program integrity  
12 initiatives or conducting internal compliance reviews and  
13 data reporting for the medical assistance program, Children's  
14 Health Insurance Program (CHIP), Pharmaceutical Assistance  
15 Contract for the Elderly (PACE) or Pharmaceutical Assistance  
16 Contract for the Elderly Needs Enhancement Tier (PACENET).

18 (12) Personnel of an organization that has an agreement  
19 to be paid on a capitated basis to provide services to  
20 medical assistance beneficiaries, who are engaged in care  
21 management, the development and evaluation of quality  
22 improvement strategies, program integrity initiatives or  
23 conducting internal compliance reviews and data reporting for  
24 the medical assistance program. Personnel engaged in these  
25 activities:

26 (i) May query the system to review the requested  
27 dispensing or prescribing of a controlled substance under  
28 this act to an individual to whom the organization  
29 provides services under Title XIX of the Social Security  
30 Act.

31 (ii) Shall notify the Department of Human Services  
32 and the Office of Attorney General if fraud is suspected  
33 based on the results of the query and review of the  
34 database.
