1 Amend Bill, page 1, line 3, by striking out the period after
2 "Bridge" and inserting
3 ; and designating that portion of State Route 4027, also known
4 as Business U.S. Route 220, over the Norfolk Southern
5 mainline railroad tracks in Grazierville, Snyder Township,
6 Blair County, as the John Frederick Bridges Memorial Bridge.

7 Amend Bill, page 1, by inserting between lines 13 and 14

8 Section 2. John Frederick Bridges Memorial Bridge.

9 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
10 follows:

11 (1) John Frederick Bridges graduated from the Tyrone
12 Area School District and enlisted in the United States Army
13 in September 1942.

14 (2) Sergeant Bridges served with distinction in the
15 778th Tank Battalion, part of General George Patton's 3rd
16 Army Division, until his death on March 7, 1945, while in
17 action in Germany.

18 (3) Sergeant Bridges was awarded the Purple Heart with
19 Oak Leaf Cluster for giving his life and protecting his men.

20 (b) Designation.--The bridge located on that portion of
21 State Route 4027, also known as Business U.S. Route 220, over
22 the Norfolk Southern mainline railroad tracks in Grazierville,
23 Snyder Township, Blair County, is hereby designated the John
24 Frederick Bridges Memorial Bridge.

25 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
26 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
27 traffic in both directions on the bridge.
