10 principal performance and shall include a comment section for  
11 additional written response. The score shall be on a one hundred  
12 (100) point scale derived from the following equally weighted  
13 questions:

14 (I) The overall parental satisfaction with the performance  
15 of the principal.

16 (II) Whether the principal engages in frequent and  
17 informative communication with the parent about the school  
18 vision and the implementation of a plan to achieve the school  
19 vision.

20 (III) Whether the principal is approachable and open to  
21 parental input.

22 (IV) Whether the principal maintains a school environment in  
23 which students feel safe.

24 (V) Whether the principal administers discipline  
25 appropriately and consistently.

26 (VI) Whether the principal provides students and parents  
27 with information about school expectations and support for  
28 learning at home.

29 (VII) Whether the principal treats students and parents with  
30 respect and care.

31 (VIII) Whether the principal acknowledges individual needs  
32 and provides appropriate individual assistance to engage  
33 students within the school.

34 (IX) Whether the principal has knowledge of and serves the  
35 needs of the communities located within the school district.

36 (X) Whether the principal supports all professional employes  
37 and nonprofessional employes with respect and opportunity for  
38 professional development.
