Under this 14 15 paragraph local authorities may charge a reasonable fee and shall comply with section 6109 (relating to specific powers 16 of department and local authorities) and the Americans with 17 18 Disabilities Act of 1990 (Public Law 101-336, 104 Stat. 327). \* \* \* 19 20 (d.1) Obstructing movement. -- A person may not obstruct a 21 space on public or private property reserved for a person with a 22 disability or a part of a curb ramp or the access aisle adjacent to a parking space reserved for a person with a disability in a 23 24 manner that would prevent a person or wheelchair or personal mobility device from entering or leaving a vehicle legally 25 parked in an adjoining space. 26 \* \* \* 27 28 (f) Penalty.--A person violating subsection (a), (b) or (d) 29 (1) is guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$15. A person 30 31 violating subsection (d)(2) or (3) or (e) is guilty of a summary 32 offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$200. If a person is 33 34 convicted under subsection (d)(2) or (3) in the absence of a sign stating the penalty amount, the fine imposed may not exceed 35 \$50. <u>A person violating subsection (d.1) is guilty of a summary</u> 36 37 offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine
