7 Amend Bill, page 4, by inserting between lines 10 and 11

8 Section 635.9. Coverage for General Assembly and Other
9 Commonwealth Employees.--No later than July 1, 2020, or the
10 conclusion of the contract for health insurance coverage that
11 was in effect on the effective date of this section, whichever
12 occurs later, the following shall only participate in health
13 insurance coverage under the Patient Protection and Affordable
14 Care Act (Public Law 111-148, 124 Stat. 119) or its successor:

15 (1) All members, officers and employes of the Senate or the
16 House of Representatives.

17 (2) All employes of the Governor's Office.

18 (3) All employes of a department, agency, office, authority,
19 board or commission of the Commonwealth that is subject to the
20 policy supervision and control of the Governor.

21 (4) All employes of the Office of Lieutenant Governor, the
22 Office of Attorney General, the Department of Auditor General or
23 the Treasury Department.

24 (5) All employes of a board or commission of an entity
25 specified in paragraph (4).

26 (6) All employes of a department, agency, office, authority,
27 board or commission of the Commonwealth that is not subject to
28 the policy supervision and control of the Governor.

29 Amend Bill, page 4, line 11, by striking out "Section 2.
30 This act shall take effect in 30 days." and inserting

31 Section 2. The provisions of this act are nonseverable. If
32 any provision of this act or its application to any person or
33 circumstance is held invalid, the remaining provisions or

1 applications of this act are void ab initio. This
2 nonseverability clause is controlling.
3 Section 3. This act shall take effect as follows:
4 (1) The addition of section 635.8 of the act shall take
5 effect in 30 days.
6 (2) The remainder of this act shall take effect
7 immediately.
