9 Section 635.9. Coverage for General Assembly and Other
10 Commonwealth Employees.--No later than July 1, 2020, or the
11 conclusion of the contract for health insurance coverage that
12 was in effect on the effective date of this section, whichever
13 occurs later, the following shall only participate in health
14 insurance coverage under the Patient Protection and Affordable
15 Care Act (Public Law 111-148, 124 Stat. 119) or its successor:

16 (1) All members, officers and employees of the Senate or the
17 House of Representatives.

18 (2) All employees of the Governor's Office.

19 (3) All employees of a department, agency, office, authority,
20 board or commission of the Commonwealth that is subject to the
21 policy supervision and control of the Governor.

22 (4) All employees of the Office of Lieutenant Governor, the
23 Office of Attorney General, the Department of Auditor General or
24 the Treasury Department.

25 (5) All employees of a board or commission of an entity
26 specified in paragraph (4).

27 (6) All employees of a department, agency, office, authority,
28 board or commission of the Commonwealth that is not subject to
29 the policy supervision and control of the Governor.

30 Section 2. The provisions of this act are nonseverable. If
31 any provision of this act or its application to any person or
32 circumstance is held invalid, the remaining provisions or
33 applications of this act are void ab initio. This
34 nonseverability clause is controlling.

35 Section 3. This act shall take effect as follows:

1 (1) The addition of section 635.8 of the act shall take
2 effect in 30 days.
3 (2) The remainder of this act shall take effect
4 immediately.
