- 9 <u>Section 635.9. Coverage for General Assembly and Other</u>
- 10 Commonwealth Employes. -- No later than July 1, 2020, or the
- 11 conclusion of the contract for health insurance coverage that
- 12 was in effect on the effective date of this section, whichever
- 13 occurs later, the following shall only participate in health
- 14 insurance coverage under the Patient Protection and Affordable
- 15 <u>Care Act (Public Law 111-148, 124 Stat. 119) or its successor:</u>
- 16 <u>(1) All members, officers and employes of the Senate or the</u>
  17 House of Representatives.
  - (2) All employes of the Governor's Office.
  - (3) All employes of a department, agency, office, authority, board or commission of the Commonwealth that is subject to the policy supervision and control of the Governor.

- 30 Section 2. The provisions of this act are nonseverable. If 31 any provision of this act or its application to any person or
- 32 circumstance is held invalid, the remaining provisions or
- 33 applications of this act are void ab initio. This
- 34 nonseverability clause is controlling.
- 35 Section 3. This act shall take effect as follows:

- (1) The addition of section 635.8 of the act shall take 1 2 effect in 30 days.
- 3 (2) The remainder of this act shall take effect immediately. 4
